Parent Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct covers all activities held by Team 7393 electronVolts, and will be in effect during the season and the off-season, which includes (but is not limited to) team meetings, driving and judging practice sessions, build sessions, competition events, and any outreach activities. Parents and team members are expected to comply with all parts of the Code of Conduct in order to be considered an eligible participant in team activities.

As a parent of a student on the team, a parent acknowledges the receipt of this code of conduct, which consists of the following rules:

- I agree to display Gracious Professionalism and show respect at all team activities, and to show respect to team members, coaches, spectators, event volunteers and officials, regardless of team affiliation. Gracious Professionalism is a strongly emphasized aspect of FIRST and also of electronVolts. I understand my conduct also reflects directly upon the team, our parent organization PIE3, other parents, and sponsors.
- I agree to use only respectful language.
- I acknowledge all team members in good standing shall attend all events designated by their coaches. Should a situation occur such as illness, required school or family event, the team member must make prior arrangements with their coaches for an excused absence.
- I understand that I am responsible for my child at event competitions and outreach activities, including behavior, team uniform, providing food/drink, etc.
- I understand and agree to read team emails and keep informed about team events.
- I agree to try to resolve any conflict or issue in an orderly manner. Concerns involving my child, and their team or coaches, should be addressed with the team coaches.
- I agree to pay yearly dues before the season kickoff, and I acknowledge that these dues are non-refundable.
- I agree to follow safety practices at team meetings, tournaments, and outreach events.
- I understand violations of the above rules could result in me or my child being barred from future team activities.

The following process will guide violations of the code of conduct. The team is designed to provide a safe and fun environment for everyone, and the coaches and mentors are committed to make this happen.

Small Infractions – examples: harsh language; aggressive arguing

- A verbal warning and discussion with coach
- 2nd time – discuss with two coaches; written notice to parent; asked to leave meeting
- 3rd time – take a break from the team for one week
- 4th time – removal from the team

Large Infractions – examples: safety violation; unsportsmanlike behavior at tournament

- Immediate dismissal from the meeting or event
- 2nd time – dismissal from from the team
